The Notice of Race is changed as follows, deletions shown with strikethrough and additions underlined:

### Schedule:

#### Saturday

<del>1000 – 1030</del>	<del>Check in (required prior to racing)</del>
1030 – 1045	Competitor's briefing
1115 – 1145	Practice starts (when available)
1200	First warning signal
After racing	Party at clubhouse with <del>dinner included for competitors</del> <u>food available for purchase</u>

#### Sunday

1015 – 1045	Practice starts (when available)
1100	First warning signal
1600	No warning signal after this time
After racing	Awards party at clubhouse

The Sailing Instructions are changed as follows, deletions shown with strikethrough and additions underlined:

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be made from a race committee signal boat while moored at Shilshole Marina ~~with sight of the CYC clubhouse~~ at the CYC clubhouse, dock W, or dock X.
- 8.3 All rounding marks other than gate marks and mark F must be left to port. When mark F is used as a rounding mark, a boat must ~~round by crossing~~ also cross the finishing line from the direction of the last mark when rounding, leaving F to port or starboard depending on the course. When mark S is used as a rounding mark following a leeward mark, a boat must also cross the starting line from the direction of the last mark when rounding.
- 8.4 A leeward rounding mark may be a gate mark when the mark letter is repeated (XX, YY, or ZZ) in the course description. If one of the gate marks is missing, the course at that mark is to round the remaining mark to port.
- ~~9.2 Starting visual signal flag P may be replaced by a blue cylindrical shape. This changes RRS 26.~~

The Sailing Instructions, Attachment A: Mark Descriptions, Buoy Course Marks, is updated in Key and Notes sections to reflect change to Sailing Instructions 8.4 noted above.
