Registration and Equipment: It is mandatory that the following documents be emailed by September 1, 2022, to the CYC office at office@cycseattle.org:

- Event waiver
- Valid IJCA measurement certificate
- Proof of current marine liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$300,000.

Courses: Courses will typically be windward / leeward and may include gates, offsets, and gybe marks. Four to six races are targeted for each day. Target race duration is 30 to 60 minutes.

Scoring: A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, except that a boat's worst score will be excluded if five or more races are completed. This changes RRS A2.1. Three races will constitute a championship.

Time Limit: Ninety minutes for the first boat in class to *finish*. Other boats must *finish* within 30 minutes of the first boat that *finishes*.

Launching and Moorage: The current plan is to launch all boats using the two cranes at Shilshole Marina. The key to operate crane is available at the CYC Seattle office (206-789-1919). Delivery from Shilshole Marina to Leschi Marina on Lake Washington takes about two hours. Boats should ensure they have two long mooring lines for passage through the Ballard Locks and an air horn for alerting the Fremont Bridge tender. A chart of the waterway from Shilshole to the Leschi Marina will be provided at registration. Alternatively, there is a launch ramp on Lake

Washington.

Guest moorage will be available and assignments provided at registration.

- The top finisher of the Western Regionals will quality for the 2023 Worlds. If this finisher has already qualified for the Worlds, the second place finisher will qualify, etc.
